### Edinburgh Residential Visit – Parent Meeting

### Year 6 Revision Club

After half term, we will start to think a little more about the end of KS2 SATs assessments, which take place Monday 12<sup>th</sup> – Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> May 2025, and will build some opportunities into the usual weekly routines, for children to work on key knowledge, skills and understanding. As part of this, Mr Jervis and I would like to run an after school 'revision club'. This will be a very laid-back opportunity for children to work closely with us on aspects of the curriculum that they may wish to work on, or that we feel needs a little more support.
