Date Change – We have a clash for our Easter/Spring Celebration and will have to unfortunately change the date to Thursday 3rd April – 2pm at The Chapel. Apologies for the inconvenience.

Attendance – Every Day Counts. Historically, at Kirkoswald CE Primary School, staff have endeavoured to be as reasonable as possible where occasional, one-off term time absences are concerned but, as you are aware, there has been a change in the government's position on such absences during term time for those in statutory education and this has affected my ability to authorise them. The Department for Education allows a Head Teacher the discretion to consider authorising a leave of absence in term time, only in 'exceptional circumstances'. This is monitored closely by our Local authority Attendance Officer on a half-termly basis. We are having more requests for term time absences which would not be deemed 'exceptional circumstances'. Additionally, you may be aware that any child of statutory school age, who has 10 sessions (5 days) of unauthorised absence would be highlighted by the attendance officer and issued with a fixed penalty notice, of which 585 have been issued across the Local Authority.

May I also take this opportunity to remind you that our school day starts at 9:00am, when key teaching and learning begins. Any child arriving after the register closes at 9:20am, is automatically recorded as late (code U) which is not authorised, and will count as an absence for that school session.
