## Kirkoswald CE School Sport Statement – Year 2023-24

In the academic year stated above; Kirkoswald CE School received £16,740 in a PE and Sports Grant.

This funding has been spent as follows:

- <u>Swimming</u>-£160 has been spent on swimming at our local outdoor pool to ensure that the children in Y3/4 are able to swim and encouraged parents of less confident swimmers to take up further lessons enabling all children to swim 25m and perform safe self-rescue by the end of year 6.
- <u>Local sports events</u> £ 100 has been used for hire of the community minibus to enable children in all years to take part in local sports events. These have included gymnastics, cross country, netball, football, rounders, and young sports leaders' events.
- **Football coaches** £3412.50 has been used to enable the school to pay for specialist football coaches thereby increasing the quality of the PE provision across all age ranges.
- <u>Specialist PE Teacher</u> £7,762 was committed to employ a specialist PE teacher for 0.20 of each week, enabling a high quality, comprehensive range and progression of PE activities to be planned, monitored, and evaluated across all age ranges.
- **Outdoor activities** £200 has been used to upgrade the learning outside the classroom provision, therefore providing greater opportunities for outdoor activities.
- <u>PE Equipment</u> £450 Has been spent on maintaining, replacing and providing new PE equipment to support the deliver of a wide range of PE activities and enhance playtime opportunities.
- Buses to various events £1250

- The profile of PE is well supported and established across the school.
- The delivery of PE is of high quality across all key stages.
- Pupils enjoy and engage in a wide range of physical activities.
- Pupils have opportunities to take part in competitions against other schools.
- Pupils are encouraged and supported to lead healthy, active lifestyles.
- PE helps build character, co-operation, collaboration and embed values such as fairness and respect.
- PE equipment replaced regularly with the introduction of new equipment allowing children to access new skills
